FORD PERFORMANCE SPORTS CAR PYRAMII


Ford Performance has created a pathway for Mustang enthusiasts (and established drivers) to reach the upper echelons of global sports car racing:

1. Starting in a Mustang Dark Horse at a Ford Performance driving experience, budding drivers are taught the fundamental techniques to drive a performance vehicle on the limit, within a safe environment.

2. From there, a driver can enter the cost-effective Mustang Cup and develop their race craft within a field of Mustang Dark Horse Rs.

3. The Mustang Challenge is the natural progression for drivers competing in the Mustang Cup (or the already seasoned racer) as it provides close, competitive racing in front of large crowds and streamed to a global audience. Series champions can accept a cash prize or a test in a Mustang GT4 car.

- 4. The Mustang GT4 is a step up from the Dark Horse R, with an increased number of racing-specific components competing against a field of other OEMs and hungry drivers vying to progress their careers.
- 5. The pinnacle of sports car racing, the track-built Mustang GT3 features more power, more aero, more adjustable components and less overall weight. This is a V8 beast like no other and the car you will see competing in the 24 Hours at Daytona and 24 Hours of Le Mans.

The Ford Performance Junior Team is an exciting initiative designed to discover and nurture the future stars of sports car racing. This dynamic program identifies promising young drivers and equips them with the tools and support they need to unlock their potential and continue their progression through the Ford Performance sports car pyramid.

- Hands-on coaching during select race weekends
- Access to simulator sessions supported by Ford Performance engineers
- Physical and mental conditioning required for racing
- Sponsorship and social media strategies to navigate a professional motorsport career

The 2025 class consists of Marco Signoretti (Canada), Erik Evans (USA), Nathan Vanspringel (Belgium), Robert Noaker (USA), Sam Paley (USA), and Jenson Altzman (USA).






